


•Use citations in the main body of your assignment.





•List all the sources you have used in a <u>reference list</u> at the end of your assignment.






Top 5 Tips to successful referencing

- 1. Find sources that help to support your assignment.
- 2. Save a list of all the sources used as you find them
- 3. Cite your references in your essay.
- 4. Format your references to the <u>correct style</u> and be consistent and accurate.
